## MASTER OF THEOLOGICAL STUDIES ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Academic Requirements: Baccalaureate Degree from an institution of higher education approved by a Canadian provincial authority, or the demonstrated educational equivalent. Grade average minimum must be 72%/B/3.0 during last 60 credits of course weight.
- Personal Requirements: Willingness to engage in a program that is broadly ecumenical and multifaith, and readiness to engage deeply in personal and spiritual reflection as part of a learning community. These will be assessed through the applicant's written statements and admissions interview.
- Language Requirements: All applicants must be proficient in English prior to admission. Proficiency is demonstrated by either (a) possession of a prior degree where the primary language of instruction was English, (b) demonstration of sufficient coursework completed in English, or (c) a satisfactory score on an approved English language examination (either TOEFL iBT, IELTS, CAEL, or PTE Academic). For full details, see the "English Language Proficiency" section of the St. Stephen's College Academic Calendar.

Interview: Applicants will attend an admission interview that will reflect on the applicant's learning goals and determine her/his appropriateness for admission to the program.

Orientation Day and Program Start Date: Upon admission, students are expected to register for the St. Stephen's College Orientation Day (usually in early June). Incoming students can expect to take their first course in early June of their starting year.

#### **APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

All documents submitted in support of this application become the property of St Stephen's College and are not returnable to the applicant or transferable to any third party. All materials will be kept strictly confidential. All materials must be received in order for your application to be considered complete. Keep a copy of the completed application packet for your files. Prospective students should submit the following documentation:

- 1. The attached application form with required statements.
- 2. The non-refundable application fee.
- 3. Transcript(s): Official and Complete Transcript issued by the institution awarding the degree and certified by an authorized officer of that institution mailed or emailed directly to St Stephen's College; includes all courses taken and grades received for all years attended, is complete to the last date of attendance, and where applicable states the degree and the date the degree was or will be awarded. If the degree awarded includes transfer credits from other institutions, a transcript from the credit-granting institution is also required. Baccalaureate Degree in related area must have GPA minimum 72%/B/3.0 during last 60 credits of course weight. Applicants should submit official transcripts for all academic work put forward in support of the application. Applicants whose transcripts are in a language other than English must submit certified translations of all transcripts being submitted as part of the application.
- 4. If language of instruction for prior degree was not English, proof of satisfactory score on an approved English language examination, referring to English Language Proficiency policy in Academic Calendar.
  - 6. Curriculum vitae in summary form. This document should include:
    - Professional experience: Position, place, and duration
    - Post-secondary education: Degrees, diplomas and certificates held, with institutions and dates
    - Other experience, education or training related to proposed program
- 6. Two to three page statement of personal and professional goals in relation to the proposed course of study.
- 7. One page statement of your spiritual journey.
- 8. Two letters of reference sent directly to College (using Reference Form which is part of the application).
  - (a) one letter should be from a member of the leadership team in the applicant's volunteer or professional setting
  - (b) include one academic referee if within 3 years of graduating.

Referees are to indicate the length and nature of their relationship to the applicant, and comment on the following points, as possible:

- Character, personality, and capacity for personal growth and development
- Academic ability
- Capacity for work in an educational model that emphasizes reflection on experience and personal growth as well as knowledge and skill development
- Emotional stability
- Leadership and vocational qualities
- General readiness for pursuing their goals by means of the proposed course of study

**Application deadline:** February 1 for Canadian and Permanent Resident applicants. November 1 for international applicants and applicants applying for a Baccalaureate equivalency review. Equivalency fee \$225; if equivalency is granted, applicants then pay the normal application fee.

#### **EQUIVALENCIES PROCEDURE**

An application from persons who do not possess a Baccalaureate Degree will be considered if the applicant possesses satisfactory alternate educational experience. In such cases, the Dean will require evidence of readiness to proceed. The Dean's decision whether or not to accept an application is final.

Prospective applications for whom special consideration is required should submit all supporting documentation (see Admission Requirements), together with any additional assessments, transcripts, and certificates earned in lieu of a Baccalaureate Degree. A non-refundable equivalency fee of \$225 must be included. The Dean's Office will review all documentation, and where it is deemed further exploration is warranted, may assign additional requirements to test eligibility. If equivalency is granted, the applicant will be invited to the intake process, and will pay the non-refundable regular application fee.
